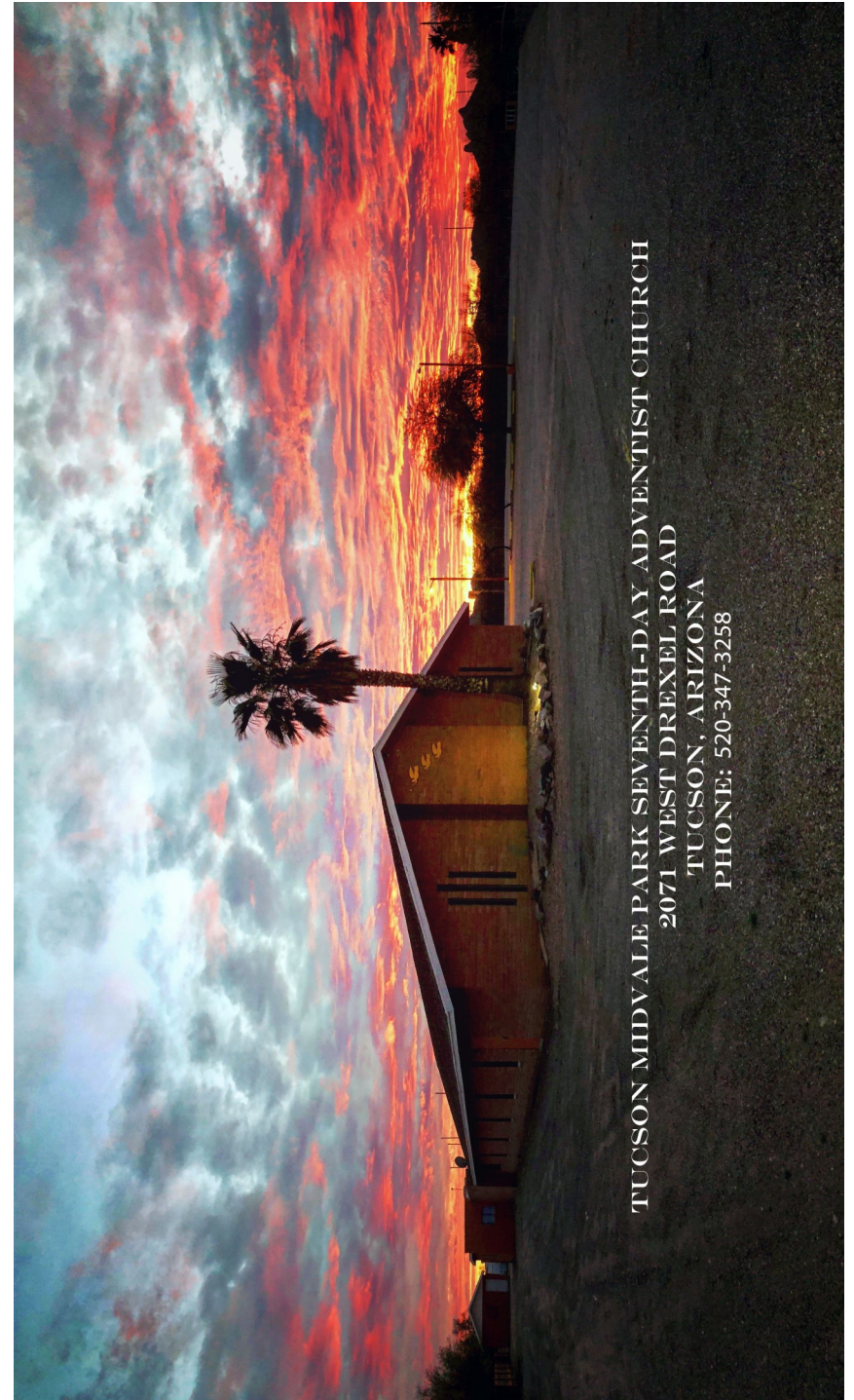
Kitchen:
